- * Enquiring into reports: The committee investigates reports of ragging and takes action against students who are found to have been involved.
- * Preventing ragging : The committee works to prevent ragging by monitoring activities and taking action to stop it.

Educating students : The committee teaches students about ragging and its consequences, including legal consequences.
